Billing Overview

RCE is pay-as-you-go and settled monthly with tiered pricing.

Pay-as-You-Go tiered pricing

Note :

The pay-as-you-go bill of each month will be settled on the first day of the following calendar month. If your account balance is insufficient for the payment, your service will be suspended.

Tier (Calls)	USD/Call
(0,1 million]	0.021
(1 million,2.5 million]	0.017
(2.5 million,5 million]	0.01
(5 million,10 million]	0.006
>10 million	0.004

Billing example

Let's suppose that your call volume in January is 2 million calls, then as shown in the pay-as-you-go tiered pricing table, some of the calls fall into the tier of (0,1 million], and some into (1 million,2.5 million], and the fees will be calculated at the cumulative tiered prices, i.e., $0.021 * 1000000 + 0.017 * 1000000 = 38000$ USD. The pay-as-you-go bill for January will be generated at 0:00 on February 1, and the fees will be directly deducted from your account balance. If your account balance is insufficient, your service will be suspended.
