ASR

Automatic Speech Recognition (ASR) is to convert the lexical content of human speeches into computer-readable input, such as keystrokes, binary codes, or character sequences. It is different from "speaker recognition" or "speaker confirmation" that recognizes or confirms speaking humans rather than words, phrases, or sentences contained in speeches.

IM

Instant Messaging

Tencent Cloud Instant Messaging (IM) is developed based on the IM capabilities. Its SDK integrates capabilities such as chat, conversation, group, and profile management to help send and receive rich media messages, including text, images, short audios, and short videos, so as to fully meet diversified communication needs.

Audio Moderation System

Audio Moderation System (AMS) can automatically recognize content in audio that may be offensive, unsafe, or inappropriate. It allows you to customize blocked keywords to recognize custom types of audio content.

Application Programming Interface

Application programming interface (API) refers to the code that a software system provides for an application to call. Developers can call a set of functional APIs without having to consider the underlying source code or understand the internal working mechanisms.

API includes Windows API and Linux API.

Autonomous Sensory Meridian Response

Autonomous sensory meridian response (ASMR) refers to the pleasant and unique stimulation produced by the human body through visual, auditory, tactile, olfactory, and other perceptual stimuli in the brain, scalp, back, or other parts of the body. It is also called braingasm.
